Renal Cysts and Diabetes Syndrome

Mode of Inheritance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Autosomal dominant• Variable expressivity and incomplete penetrance
Renal Phenotype	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Variable, including: renal cysts, hypodysplasia, interstitial fibrosis, and various other structural abnormalities
Extra-renal Manifestations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mature-onset diabetes of youth (MODY)• Subclinical abnormal LFTs• Neonatal cholestasis• Pancreatic hypoplasia• Genital tract abnormalities• Hyperuricemia and early-onset gout• Hypomagnesemia• Autism, ADHD, and developmental delay
Pre-Transplant Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Screening and management of extra-renal manifestations
Transplant Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Careful screening of potential living related donors (inherited in an autosomal dominant manner)
Post-Transplant Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Low risk of disease recurrence• Minimize exposure to pro-diabetogenic medications
